Dear Parent/Carer

Following our earlier email and the speech by the Prime Minister, the government advice has now changed.

Initially, the advice was that only the person with symptoms needed to self-isolate, not those that lived in the same household and presented no symptoms themselves. The advice is now that if one person in a household has either a cough and/or a temperature (above 37.8 degrees), then the whole household should self-isolate for 14 days.
