Please find attached a letter from Cumbria County Council about the arrangements in schools during the school closure period starting next week.

In line with government guidance, children should be kept at home if at all possible. UCC is providing a comprehensive home-learning programme (please see our website).

I would like to confirm that Ullswater Community College will open to the children of key workers (please see the attached letter for details of those falling into this category) and to vulnerable children, who are:

- Children who have an allocated social worker
- Children on free school meals
- Children with an educational healthcare plan (EHCP)

If your child(ren) fall into either of these categories, please let the school know if we can expect them to attend next week by emailing: prioritychildcare@ullswatercc.co.uk

You must include the name of your employer and the category you fall into in the e-mail.

School will be open between 9:30am and 3:40pm. Please can children – in full school uniform – come in to school via the drop-off point at the main school reception. Please note that we have been informed that there is no Cumbria County Council school transport provision.
